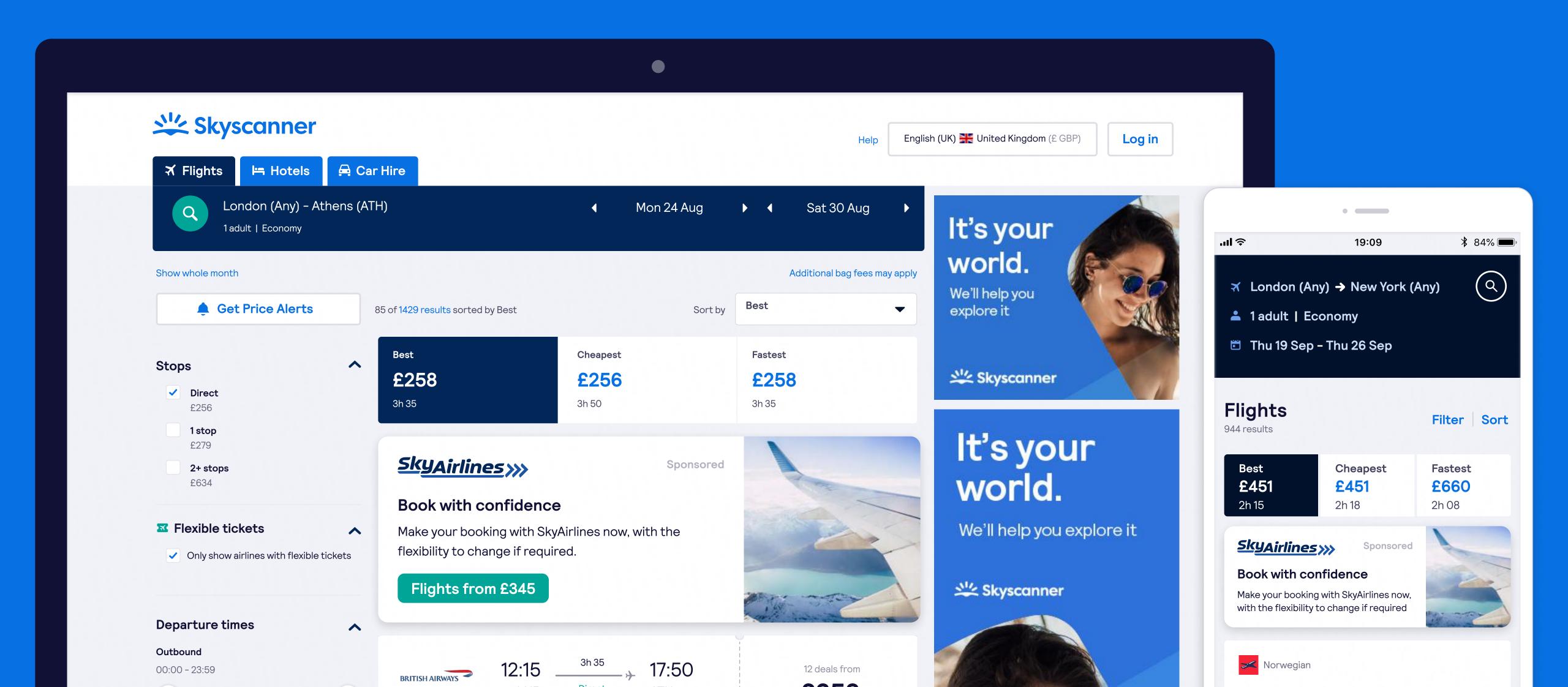

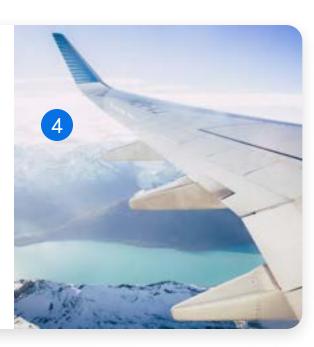

1 Please supply a high res PNG or JPG file (supplying at **x2 or x3 required size** ensures sharpest possible appearance on retina screens)

Maximum height 32px

Maximum width 160px

Please crop to the edges of your logo: no white space/empty pixels to the left or right of the logo are permitted. For example, if your logo is not 160px wide when sized at 32px high, please crop the image file to the natural width of your logo. For examples or further explanation, please see page 3.

Logo will always appear on a white background, so please supply full colour version on a white or transparent background.

- Headline maximum character limit (including spaces): **30** (sentence case only)
- 3 Sub-headline maximum character limit (including spaces): **75** (sentence case only)
- 4 Image size: 300px wide x 300px high

The image will be cropped automatically depending on the size of the device that the banner is viewed on. This size ensures the image resolution is sufficient at the largest size.

Image cannot included any text overlays. Safe areas and style of image for consideration shown on page 2.

5 Call To Action (CTA) button maximum character limit (including spaces): **20** (sentence case only)

Please note that the small screen web/app banner does not include a CTA button

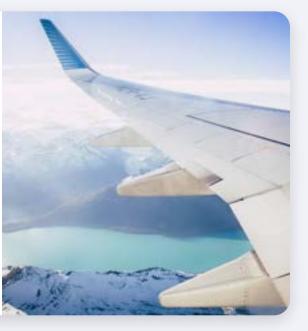

Cropping

The main image you provide may be cropped depending on size of the device that the banner is viewed on. Please check nothing important sits outside of the safe area shown below.

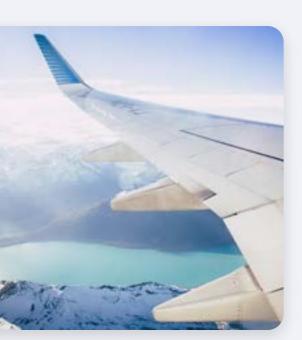

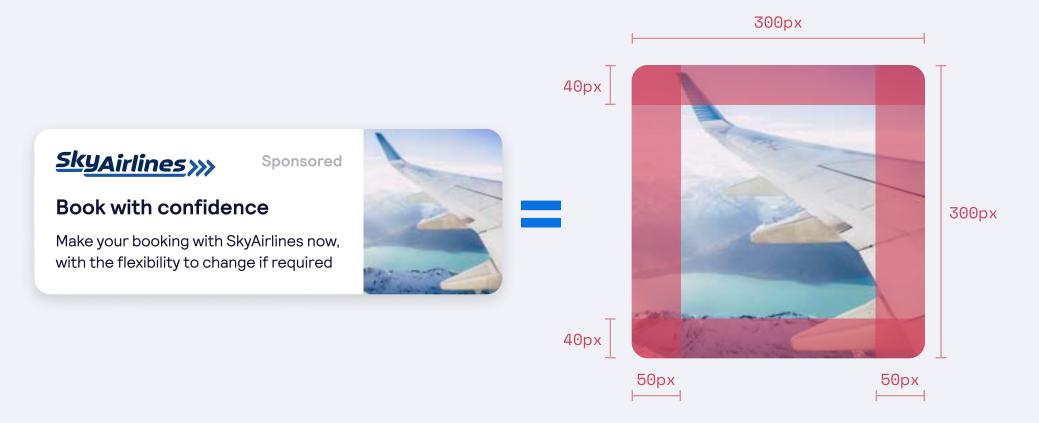

Text or communication within the image

We do not permit extra messaging embedded within the image, but if your image does contain aircraft livery or signage, be mindful of the unsafe areas of the image.

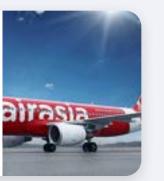

Providing your logo file as PNG or JPG

Horizontal/inline logos

If you have a horizontal/inline (wide) version of your logo, this will work best in the space.

You are not required to fill the space of both maximum dimensions. For example, when your logo is 160px wide, it might be less that 32px high. This is ok - you just need to crop your logo file to the edges of the logo, as per this example:

| |------





160 x 32 potential logo area

this logo at 160px wide = 26px high

provide your logo cropped to 160px wide by 26px high

Vertical/stacked logos

If you only have a vertical/stacked (tall) version of your logo, this will still work in the space, your logo will just appear smaller than a horizontal/inline version. This is due to the nature of the space available on this banner.

Again, you are not required to fill the space of both maximum dimensions. For example, when your logo is 32px high, it might be a lot less that 160px wide. This is ok - you just need to crop your logo file to the edges of the logo, as per this example:

160 x 32 potential logo area

logo at 32px high is 57px wide

provide your logo cropped to 32px high by 57px wide

For retina/high resolution screens

If possible, please **provide your logo at x2 or x3 the sizes outlined above**, to ensure your logo looks sharp on all screens and devices.

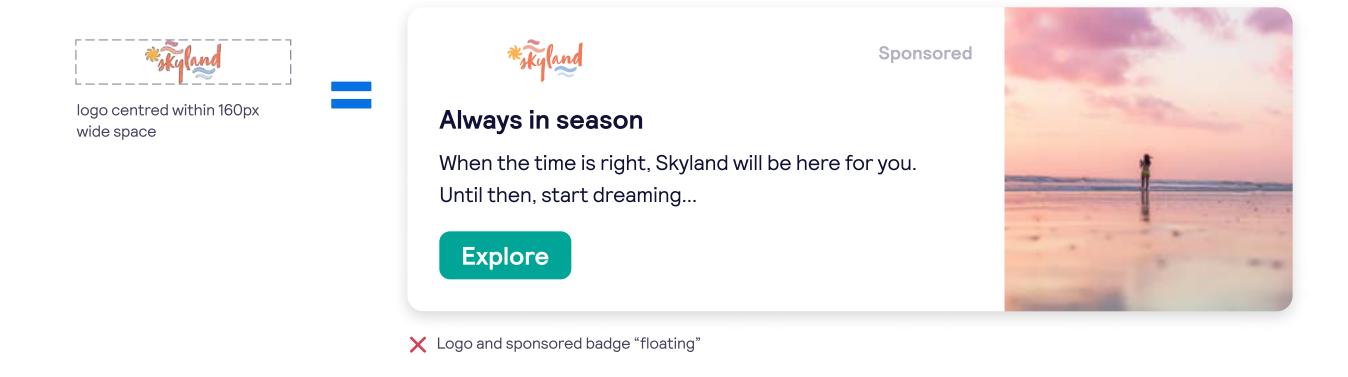
For example, the two logos above would actually be provided at: Airline example: 480px wide x 78px high (for x3 times)

DMO example: 96px high x 171px wide (for x3 times)

Empty pixels/extra white space

Please do not provide your logo file with empty pixels/extra white space either side of the logo.

This will cause an error in the alignment and spacing of the logo within the banner.

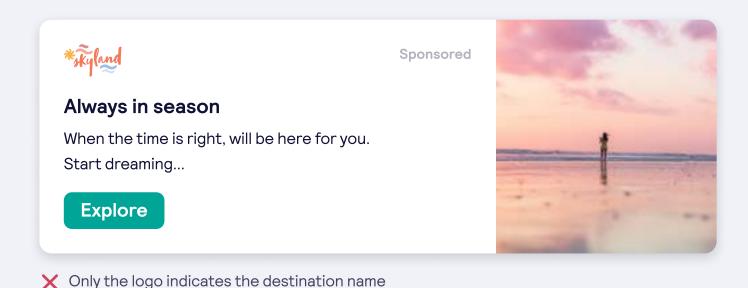


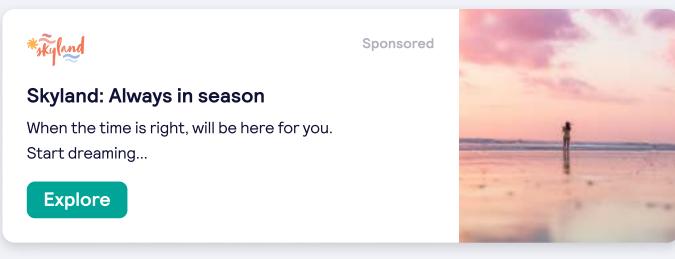


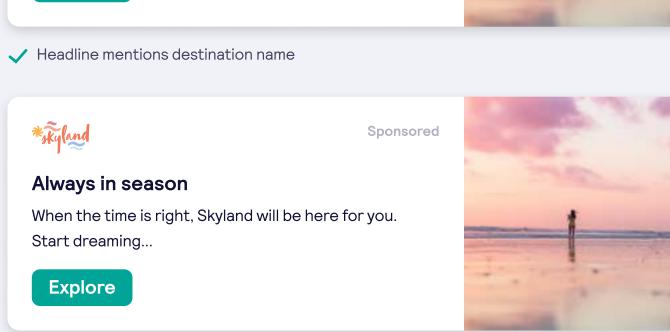
Messaging and typography

Include your brand/destination name

It is important not to rely solely on your logo to convey to the traveller who is speaking to them or what the destination is. Your logo will be relatively small, especially on small screen devices, so it is especially crucial if your logo is mainly image-based or uses playful letterforms, to include the name of your brand or destination in the messaging.





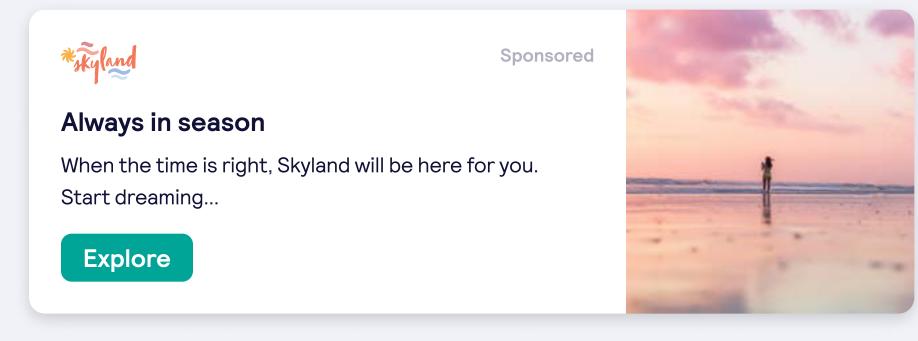


✓ Sub-headline mentions destination name

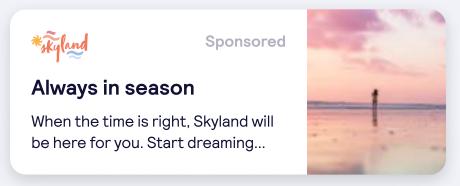
Include a call to action within your messaging

For our small screen format there is no Call To Action button, so we advise your messaging takes this into consideration.

Desktop with CTA button

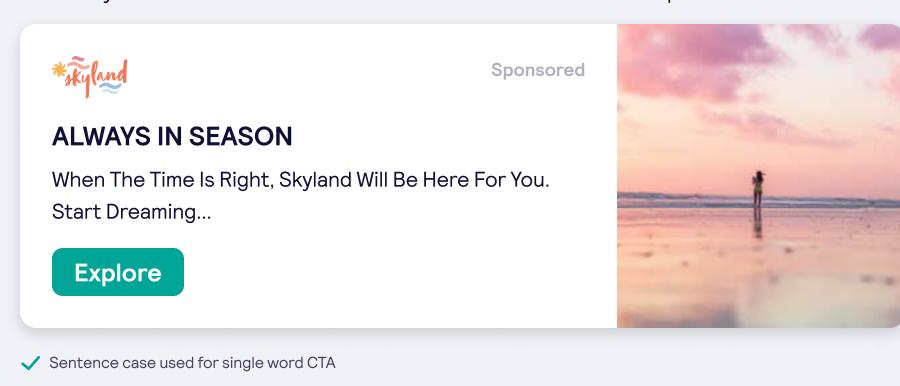


Small screen web/app: no button



Use sentence case for all messaging

Please do not use ALL CAPS or Title Case for any of the messaging, including the CTA button text. Only the first letter of the first word in a sentence should be capitalised.



- X ALL CAPS used for headline
- X Title Case used for sub-headline
